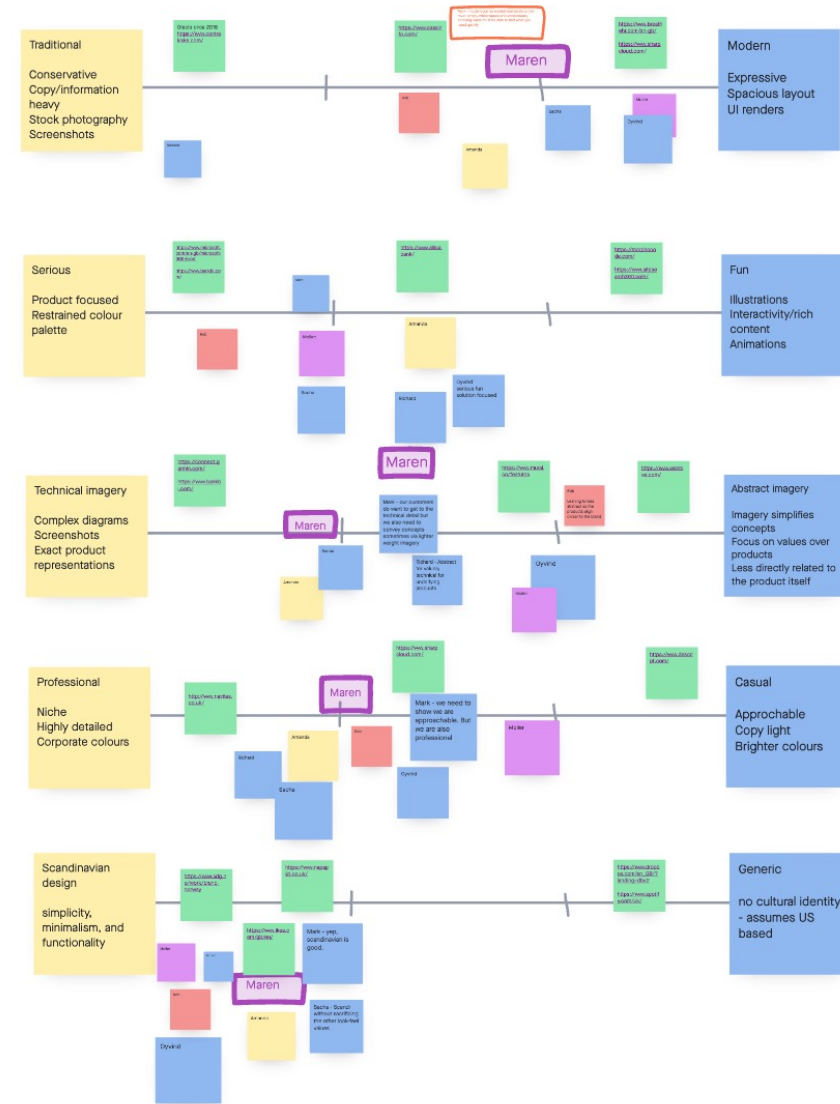


1. Consolidate Safran's brand with input and buy-in from key stakeholders.

Safran for Statoil

Statoil har besluttet å gå til anskaffelse av en lokal utviklet programvare. Planleggingsverktøyet Safran Planner er utviklet av stavangerbedriften Safran

Software Solutions AS. Selskapet håper på pangsalg etter kontrakten med Statoil.

Programvareprodusenten vil ikke ut med verdien på kontrakten med Statoil, men Rogalands Avis får opplyst at beløpet ligger i millionklassen.

Planleggingsverktøyet er utviklet av Safran Software Solutions AS i Stavanger.

Safran vant Statoils gunst i sterk konkurranse med store software-konsern som Microsoft.

Lillebror

Safran Planner er et planleggings-verktøy som er utviklet til alt fra

hjemmebruk til store bedrifter. Verktøyet er beregnet på enkeltbrukere.

– Dette er et beslektet produkt med prosjektstyringsverktøyet Safran Project. Dette dataverktøyet ble brukt av Statoil i forbindelse med Åsgard-prosjektet. Safran Planner er en lillebror, forteller regionssjefen stolt.

Safran Software har i samarbeid med Statoil utviklet dette planleggingsverktøyet, men er åpent for kommersielt bruk over hele verden.

Fart i salget

Regionssjef Andreassen håper at kontrakten med Statoil skal gi fart i programvaresalget.

– Statoils valg av Safran Planner bekrefter at vi har lyktes i å utvikle et produkt som appellerer til en meget bredt sammensatt gruppe av brukere, fra dem som vil lage en plan i ny og ne, til daglig planlegging og prosjektstyring, sier han.

Safran Software er en del av det finske Proha-konsernet. Det gir tilgang til 26 land og store mulig-

heter på verdensmarkedet. Programvareprodusenten har derfor stor tro på at Safran Planner kan selge godt i utlandet.

Lokalt firma

Safran Software Solutions AS har sitt hovedkontor i Rogaland Kunnskapspark på Ullandhaug, og hadde i 1999 en omsetning på 11 millioner kroner.

Selskapet, med 12 ansatte, ble etablert i 1997 og ledes av Steinar Dalva. Det finske konsernet eier 60 prosent av selskapets aksjer.

Safran Planner, som er windowsbasert, er til salgs i butikkhyllene til 3995 kroner. Verktøyet kan også lastes ned fra dataselskapets web-side: www.safran.no

Ifølge Statoil forventer de at planleggingsverktøyet skal effektivisere arbeidsprosessene innen prosjektplanlegging.

– Safran Planner er brukervennlig og funksjonelt, sier Kari Gro Johanson, kompetanse- og verktøysansvarlig innen sektor for prosjektutvikling i Statoil.

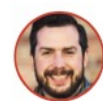
